What Are Indicators?

Indicators are measurable information used to determine if a program is implementing their program as expected and achieving their outcomes. Not only can indicators help understand what happened or changed but can also help you to ask further questions about how these changes happened. The choice of indicators will often inform the rest of the evaluation plan, including evaluation methods, data analysis, and reporting. Strong indicators can be quantitative or qualitative and are part of the evaluation plan. In evaluation, the indicators should be reviewed and used for program improvement throughout the program’s life cycle. [READ MORE](#)
